Guiding Principles

- 1. Treat all users and colleagues fairly and equally.
- 2. Be civil; refrain from personal attacks and insinuations.
- 3. Do not import other members' postings, pictures, and personal information, from alternate social media sources unto the Swesco WhatsApp platform without their permission.
- 4. Think before you post! Political commentary, jokes and humor can be controversial and slippery slopes. Once you post, it is hard to retract. We want an archive of discussions of which posterity will be proud.

Discussion Group Etiquette

- 1. Only send a message to the entire list if everyone can benefit from it. Four categories apply:
 - > Swesco related news: updates about Swesco educational priorities; fundraising for educational projects and initiatives.
 - ➤ **Member caring and wellness:** life events and celebrations-marriage; bereavement; accolades; notes of inspiration and encouragement.
 - > Mentoring and coaching: ideas on social and economic mobility
 - ➤ Global Affairs: awareness raising on the human condition from around the world.
- 2. All defamatory, abusive, profane, threatening, offensive, violent, or illegal material is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Discriminatory, hostile, intimidating and derogatory messages or language is strictly prohibited, whether based on a person's ethnicity, culture, social or economic class, educational level, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, age, size, family status, immigration status, political belief, religion, or mental or physical ability.
- 4. Political commentaries and opinions are not acceptable postings on the platform.
